

Regional Resiliency Action Plan
Steering Committee Web-Meeting

August 20th, 2018 | 10 am

Roll was taken.

An update of the August Workshop was provided. Currently, there are 39 registrants for the Brevard workshop on the 20th. There are 37 registrants for the Volusia workshop on the 21st. The Volusia County council meeting is on the same day as the Volusia workshop, so those officials have been invited to the Brevard workshop. After these workshops there will be a draft of the action plan sent to the steering committee in mid-September for review before the in person meeting on October 4th. This meeting will likely occur in Titusville and will be 2 hours long.

Heather and Marshall from the Tampa Regional Planning Council talked about their efforts for a regional compact/coalition. They had a technical advisory committee and a steering committee (made of council elected officials) to help guide the formulation of the MOU and provide input on the formation of the regional group. They are working with local governments to approve and sign the MOU. The council will be having a signing ceremony. Once formally established, the group will be working on goals and an action plan in the fall.

The committee went over Focus Area Objectives. For each section there were many comments and changes made each section that can be viewed on the updated Powerpoint that will be sent to the steering committee. There was discussion about wording actions or objectives in a way that they can be measurable. There was a discussion on providing indicators as part of the project. This is something that needs to be completed at some point in time, whether as part of this project or not. The conversation of indicators will be further discussed at a later date.

The next call will be on August 17th. The next meeting discuss will focus on how strongly the wording in the document should be in order to get the governments to take responsibility for development in vulnerable areas and how to specially address this through the action items.
